

British Values at Cobbs Brow Primary School: Lower KS2

Rule of Law

- School rules and making the right choices- children are encouraged to think about the difference between right and wrong
- Class rules/ code of conducts
- Visitors from the community in assemblies
- Role of community leaders eg Police

We learn about important national and international events/ history:

- Remembrance Day and WW1 and 2
- Black History Month
- Religious festivals

Democracy

- Voting opportunities: headteacher for the day', class representative on the school council
- Children are encouraged to make decisions together and know their views count and their opinions are important
- Children take part in debate- argument texts

Mutual Respect and Tolerance of Different Faiths and Beliefs

- Children are taught to respect the different beliefs of others
- Visitors from different faiths invited into school
- In RE- Christianity, Hinduism, Islam are studied as part of the curriculum
- Children study texts from different cultures in English
- Participation in fund-raising activities eg Children in Need, Red Nose Day

Individual Liberty

- 'Growth Mindset' to develop children's self-esteem and confidence in their abilities
- Through PSED children learn about 'Health and Well-being', and 'Bullying'
- Children are given roles and responsibilities in class
- A range of group arrangements within lessons- eg mixed ability pairing to encourage children to learn from each other and to be mentors
- Children have E-safety ownership and choice when using the internet appropriately.
