Rule of Law

- School rules and making the right choices
 children are encouraged to think about
 the difference between right and wrong
- Understanding there are consequences for their actions
- Team games in PE (rules) and Sports day
- Police visits and Fire Safety talks
- In the 'London's Calling' topic children learn about the Houses of Parliament and the rule of law for our country.

We learn about important national and international events

Democracy

- Voting for different choices in class-topics and activities
- Voting opportunities: headteacher for the day', class representative on the school council
- Children are encouraged to make decisions together and know their views count and their opinions are important
- In the 'London's Calling' topic children will learn about the Houses of Parliament and the democratic process.

Mutual Respect and Tolerance of

Different Faiths and Beliefs

- Through PSED children learn about 'Health and Wellbeing', 'Relationships' and 'Living in the Wider World'
- In RE- Christianity, Hinduism, Islam and Judaism are studied as part of the curriculum
- · Visitors from different faiths are invited into school
- Participation in fund-raising activities eg Children in Need, Red Nose Day- supporting children near and far
- In the 'Powerful People' topic children learn about the impact of significant people from a range of backgrounds and cultures.
