Curriculum Plan

In EYFS children are taught basic art and design skills via 'expressive arts and design' particularly using the 'creating with materials' development matters. In Nursery children are encouraged to explore colours and how colours can be changed. They begin to understand that they can use lines to enclose space and then begin to use these shapes to represent objects. Children begin to describe the texture of things and they realise that tools can be used for purpose. Throughout Reception, children explore what happens when they mix colours and textures, they understand that different media can be combined to create new effects and they manipulate a variety of tools and materials to achieve these effects. They will be encouraged to express their feelings and understandings using a range of art forms and develop their own ideas through experimentation with a range of diverse materials.

In KS1 we teach Art through the two year cycle and use a variety of Art skills. The children focus on a range of Artist during each topic area.

In KS2 we teach Art through the two year cycle. The children use repeated topics to deepen their artistic knowledge and skills.
